Southport and Formby Health started running Lincoln House Surgery on 1 January 2024.

But Southport and Formby Health will now stop running Lincoln House Surgery at the end of October 2024.



We have looked for someone else to run the surgery in the future, but we do not think we will be able to find someone to do this.

So we have decided to:



• Close the surgery.



• Move patients to another doctor's surgery near where they live.



We will only move you to a doctor's surgery if it is rated as 'good'.



What you should do

You do not need to do anything yourself.



You should keep using Lincoln House Surgery for now.



We will send you another letter in October 2024 to tell you what will happen next.




When you move to your new surgery, your health information will move without you having to do anything.


